The Middle East Association, on behalf of UK Trade & Investment and the Department for International Development, and the Palestinian Investment Promotion Agency, are delighted to announce the organisation of a major Business Forum on Trade & Investment with Palestine in London on 15-16 December 2008.

This follows the success of the Palestine Investment Conference in Bethlehem last May, and the announcement by Prime Minister Gordon Brown during his visit to Palestine in July that a follow-up conference would be held in London later this year.

The main event will take place on 15 December. A 40-strong Palestinian business delegation will participate. It will include:

- An overview of the business and investment environment;
- Panel sessions on key sectors, including finance, infrastructure and ICT;
- Updates on agri-business and tourism development;
- An open forum to discuss investment and partnership opportunities.

On 16 December the Palestinian delegates will participate in business to business roundtables hosted by International Financial Services London, the Arab British Chamber of Commerce, and British Expertise.

The Business Forum is being organised in partnership with the Palestinian Investment Promotion Agency, and the newly-formed Palestine British Business Council.
